Nomination Instructions

- Any healthcare team member (physicians, physician assistants, pharmacists, nurse practitioners, advanced practice nurses, nurses, administrative staff, and managers) can submit nominations to Horizon CME.
- Nominees must practice within the state in which the APPOS event is held, or, in a state closest to the city in which the event is held.
- Submit a letter of support (500-word limit please) along with completed nomination form to Jennifer Reynolds at jennifer.reynolds@horizoncme.com
- Only Hematology/Oncology Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, Advanced Practice Nurses, and Pharmacists in active practice (non-industry) are eligible. Active APPOS Planning Committee members and Horizon CME employees are ineligible.

Review and Notification

- The recipient will be selected by the APPOS Planning Committee based on the merit of the nomination and must meet the values/criteria of the award.
- All Nominees will be notified 4 weeks in advance of the APPOS event date.
- Winners will be announced at their local Annual APP Oncology Summit, with details to follow.
- Winners will receive a plaque, airfare, 2 nights lodging, and free registration to APPOS Honolulu or alternately, a \$750 Amazon Gift Card. Honolulu award winner will have the option to select airfare, 2 nights lodging, and free registration to any 2024 APPOS conference in lieu of Honolulu award.
